Survival Kit List

It is recommended that your survival kit items are kept in the cabin of your vehicle. If your vehicle were to roll over, you would not be able to open your trunk, tail gate or lift gate.

- blankets hat, gloves, scarves, boots bright red/orange signal cloth
- whistle flashlight w/new batteries non-perishable snacks
- empty metal can plastic bag to gather snow snow brush / scraper
- matches/lighter/plumbers candle rope razor blade
- basic tools – screw drivers, pliers, wrench, hammer
- jumper cables gas line anti-freeze clay cat litter compact shovel
- car cell phone charger
- your ICE (in case of emergency phone numbers) in your contact list
- an activity item to help keep you awake
